

At this reception and briefing, you will meet other program participants as well as U.S. government officials in Vienna for the General Conference. We will also distribute your welcome kits, badges, and review notes on the schedule

Housekeeping notes:

- 1) **Venue.** The IAEA General Conference takes place in two adjoining buildings that are connected by two corridors. On the following page you will find a map of the two venues, which are referred to as the ACV for “Austria Center Vienna” and the IAEA Compound, which is known locally as the VIC or “Vienna International Center”. You can reach these venues on the subway (U1 to Kaisermühlen/VIC), with a taxi, or with a private car (underground parking is available at the ACV). ACV address is Bruno Kreisky Platz 1, 1220 Vienna.
- 2) **Conference badge and security.** With your badge, you will have access to the IAEA compound and all areas that have been included in the security hard line for the conference.
- 3) **Our meeting rooms.** Our meeting rooms, including the Industry Reception and the America Lounge, are located in the ACV, on the first floor up (green level). We have put up signs directing people to the “America Lounge”, which is accessible using either the elevator or the escalators. Most of our program takes place in these rooms. Our rooms are outside the security hard line, thus **you do not need a badge to enter our rooms**. All meetings in these rooms were set up by our office especially for our industry program participants.
- 4) **Other meetings.** The meetings referred to in your schedule as “IAEA Side Event Meetings” were organized by the IAEA, and vetted by our office. You are cordially invited to attend these meetings. We did not include all IAEA meetings or side event meeting in your schedule, either because we felt they would not be of interest to you, or because they were by invitation only. For a complete list of meetings, please have a look at the IAEA daily program, which we will have available for your convenience in the America Lounge.
- 5) **U.S. Exhibit.** In the IAEA compound in the Rotunda is the U.S. Exhibit, which is shared by three U.S. agencies: the NNSA, NE, and the U.S. Commercial Service. Your literature and give aways are displayed at this stand, which was designed to give an overall picture of the U.S. nuclear space.
- 6) **IMPORTANT! You must enter through the main doors because on the first day of the conference, Monday the 17th, our breakfast meeting begins before either venue is officially open. You must enter through the main doors (taxi will bring you right to the door, or take the U1 underground). We will have staff on site to guide you to the room.**
- 7) Please read your agenda carefully, **there are overlapping meetings!**
