India produces 4 fuel minerals, 11 metallic minerals, 22 minor minerals, and 52 non-metallic minerals. India ranked third worldwide in the production of coal and lignite at 564 Million Metric Tons in 2014. Coal sector is India's biggest importer of mining equipment.

A snapshot of India's ranking in mineral production is given below:

- World's largest producer of mica blocs and splittings
- 3rd among coal, lignite, barites, chromite producers
- 4th in the production of iron ore
- 5th in the production of bauxite
- 6th in the production of manganese ore
- 10th in the production of aluminum
