Groundwater Remediation

Groundwater is the source of water found in wells and springs and is an essential source of drinking water. Groundwater contamination is usually very difficult to characterize and clean up, often requiring decades of treatment and monitoring. Each groundwater contamination problem is uniquely complex, yet there are many common issues related to the management and cleanup of these problems. Almost every cleanup program must devote a significant level of attention and resources to groundwater issues.

Commercial Service Philippines Completes Renewable Fuels Association Trade Mission
 The objective of the mission was for U.S. companies to gain a deeper understanding of the ethanol market and business potential in the Philippines. The U.S. Embassy Commerce, Economic and Agriculture officers and local government agencies provided in-depth presentations on the renewable fuel environment, rules and regulations, and business opportunities. As part of the trade mission, the Commercial Service Manila office arranged more than 30 828 meetings between the U.S. delegates and local Philippine companies to discuss industry trends and potential opportunities for partnership. USTDA Supports MiniGrid Solar Power Project in Tanzania
 The U.S. Trade and Development Agency provided a grant to Rex Energy, one of Tanzania's largest renewable energy solutions providers, for a mini-grid project in the Lake Victoria Islands, where only one percent of the population has access to electricity. The grant supports the development of a full-scale business model and financing plan necessary to implement a hybrid solar photovoltaic mini-grid with a cumulative capacity of 2 megawatts. A U.S. company was selected to carry out the feasibility study and pilot project. [July 2015]
