**Daubert Cromwell to Accept U.S. Dept. of Commerce Export Achievement Award**

Alsip, IL (Nov. 2010) – Daubert Cromwell will accept the U.S. Dept. of Commerce Export Achievement Certificate award in a presentation at 11 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 2, during Pack Expo International at McCormick Place, Chicago.

The Export Achievement Certificate recognizes small and medium-size companies that have entered the international marketplace for the first time or that have successfully entered a new market. Daubert Cromwell, based in Alsip, IL, used help from the Commercial Service in Chicago recently to open new selling channels for its corrosion preventive packaging in Spain. Previously, it helped Daubert Cromwell open new markets in India, Europe and South America.

The presentation will be made during Pack Expo International, the biennial exhibition sponsored by the Packaging Machinery Manufacturers Institute (PMMI), the trade organization for companies that manufacture packaging-related materials. Accepting the award will be Daubert Cromwell Director Global Business Development Scott Kotvis and President & CEO Martin J. Simpson, in Booth E-5934.

Several members of the U.S. Commercial Service Chicago office will also be present, including Director Julie Carducci, Midwest Region Director Mary Joyce and Sr. Trade Specialist Jeff Graber.

The Chicago office nominated Daubert Cromwell for the national award based on its success in helping the company navigate international markets and find suitable selling partners.

Since working with the Export Service, Daubert Cromwell established subsidiaries in China and Europe. It has since created jobs in the U.S and both countries to support those operations.
